Most importantly, nurture your fitness, not just for the body but for mental clarity and confidence.

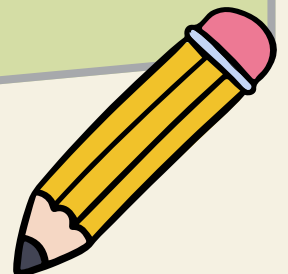
