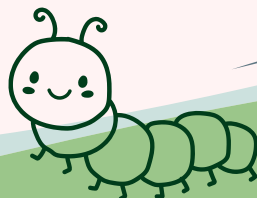

"Indeed, Allah is with those who are patient."

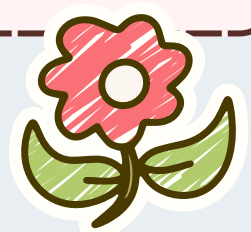
